- Penticton Airport offers daily flights from Vancouver and Calgary.

Main Plenary

Together, Ballroom 1 and Ballroom 2 offer 28,731 sq ft. Configured in theatre arrangement, the pillar-free space can accommodate up to 2,700 delegates. Ballroom 1 can be further divided by airwalls to create three separate meeting rooms for banquets, break-outs or meetings. These divided rooms are referred to as Salon A, B and C.

Breakouts

Eight concurrent break out rooms offer seating for 30 - 90 attendees, while select meeting rooms have the ability to combine to create larger breakouts to accommodate up to 180 people.





Ballrooms 1 and 2 are seamlessly connected by an air wall. When combined, the space can accommodate 160 10 ft x 10 ft booths. With power, water and drainage options, exhibitors can power up to display products and services. Add our two naturally-lit lobbies to extend the exhibit space by 14,000 sq ft.

We also offer a concession space and expolounge and can facilitate ticket sales and admission. Additionally, services and meals can be ordered in advance.

For exhibitors, the drive-in loading bay provides direct access to Ballroom 2. The 16 ft high by 16 ft wide door makes the load in and out easy.

PRE AND POST IN PENTICTON

As is the trend these days, conventions, conferences, meetings and trade shows are a mix of work and play. Penticton has much to offer those who arrive early or decide to stay on after their event.



Wineries and wine tours – There are over 170 wineries near Penticton producing more than 75 grape varietals, within three distinctly different wine regions including Naramata, Okanagan Falls and Summerland. You'll find 80 wineries within a 20 minute drive of the city. There are also several craft breweries, cideries, and distilleries to tour.



Beaches and lakes – Choose between Okanagan and Skaha lakes, on either end of the city. Long sandy beaches and water sports await. Float the Penticton River Channel that connects the two lakes on an inner tube or raft.



Outdoor adventure – hiking, kayaking, bike rentals, Kettle Valley Railway tours, and rock climbing, for starters.



Fruit stands & farmers' markets – load up before you head home.



Arts, culture & entertainment – discover studios, galleries, art installations, museums, live theatre and the symphony. Don't miss the Kettle Valley Steam Railway, the BC Hockey Hall of Fame and the SS Sicamous Museum and Heritage Park, for more reasons to stay and play.



Winter Activities – Go downhill skiing and boarding at Apex Mountain Resort, under an hour away, or cross-country skiing at the Nickel Plate Nordic Centre. Ice skate at night on a 1 km loop through the forest or on our NHL-sized outdoor rink. Try a backcountry snowshoe or rent a fat bike and hit the trails.
